



Home School Agreement

Remote Learning using Google Meet for live sessions

Google Meet will be used as the platform for online meetings whilst Remote Learning takes place. This home school agreement between staff, parents and pupils will ensure the most productive meetings can take place for all. Recordings of meetings are not to be shared outside of the school environment.

The School:

- Set up and provide Google Meet as a safe and secure learning platform for communication.
- Set clear expectations for the use of Google Meet.
- Ensure all pupils have a chance to contribute.
- Will schedule live meetings in a fair manner meaning pupils who share devices at home can still access meetings.
- Will inform parents/carers if their child has behaved inappropriately.
- Will use the platform to communicate with pupils only and not to contact parents.

The Parent/Carer:

- Ensure their child has an appropriate quiet space to work in and join the live meeting.
- Will supervise where appropriate and let their child work independently where appropriately.
- Will inform the school if they see or feel anything is inappropriate.
- Will support their child to get online and be able to attend the meeting on time.
- Where siblings are sharing devices, will ensure the devices are shared fairly between family members and inform school if this means children may not attend meetings.
- Will ensure their children do not share any content from the online platform outside of the school.

The Child:

- Follow the rules and expectations, including to not use the chat function inappropriately.
- Will be suitably dressed in live meetings.
- Will attend live meetings with any resources they need (e.g pencil, exercise book)
- Will be respectful to everyone in the meeting and in their Google Meet group.
- Will tell their parents/carers if they see or feel anything is inappropriate.
- Will try their best to take part in online meetings and complete any work set fully, making the best use of all learning resources.
- Will not change their profile picture
