Week 1

(Settle any new children, EYFS new starters won't be able to book onto the system for the first week or two so we won't know exactly who will be in on what days. I would presume if they have an older sibling attending then the new EYFS child will be as well.) I have attached a list of provisional new starters names and possible days that they will be attending.) Please remember that for the first few weeks classes 1 and 2 children will need to be escorted to their classrooms until they become confident with where they are going. Also, for the first week classes 1 and 2 children are to bring their things into the hall and take them with them at the end of the session. After the first week they should know where their things go so should be able to put their things away when they first arrive.

Tues Colouring pictures on table also plain paper for free drawing. (outside weather dependent)

Wed table top games, free colouring and drawing, dominoes on the floor

Thur floor equipment and circus stuff (outside weather dependent)

Fri jigsaws and floor equipment (outside weather dependent)

Week 3

Mon floor games such as snakes and ladders, chess, noughts and crosses etc

Tues Autumn mindfulness colouring

Wed floor equipment and free drawing

Thur autumn craft. Animals and leaves cutting and sticking. Encourage and support EYFs children who need help. May need to cut some leaves out for EYFs

Fri cosmic kids' yoga

Mon Floor equipment

Tues free drawing and colouring

Wed circus equipment, skipping ropes, bats and balls, beanbags and bucket

Thur team games such as grannies' footsteps, pass the beanbag, down on one knee

Wed table top games and jigsaws

Thur floor equipment and colouring

Fri bats, balls, bean bags, skipping ropes and hoops.

Mon floor equipment and drawing

Wed team games such as grannies' footsteps, down on one knee, hot potato

Fri floor equipment and colouring

Mon circus equipment, skipping ropes, bean bags and hoops
