



Keeping Safe On-line Guide

Advice for Key Stage 1 Pupils



1. Personal Information

Never give out any information about yourself online, like your full name, date of birth, address, home phone number or the school you go to.



Don't use your real name when using games or websites on the internet - use a nickname.



2. Your Password - Top Secret!

Don't tell anyone your passwords.



3. Think Before You Send

Remember that when you send a message to someone, you cannot see how your words or pictures make them feel. What you think is a joke may really hurt their feelings so don't send unkind messages or pictures.



Be polite and sensible online.

4. Block The Bully

If you get an unkind message or picture, tell an adult. Don't delete the message or picture. Don't reply to an unkind message - it's what the bully wants.



5. Stranger Danger

Never make friends with people you don't know. Block these people and report any concerns to an adult you trust. Never agree to meet up with anyone who you don't already know.



Only email people you know and trust.

6. Make Sure You Tell

If you see anything online which upsets you, tell an adult at home who can help you to report it to the right place. You can also tell your teacher, Mrs Shields or any member of staff who will help you.
