Learn to listen carefully to adults and to each other.

Listen to and learn rhymes, songs and stories

Re-tell familiar stories

Ask questions to find out more

Engage with non-fiction books to find out new information

Learn and use new vocabulary

Use talk to organise thinking, work out problems and to explain ideas

Describe events that have happened

### Mathematics

Compare and order apples by size

Weigh out ingredients during cooking

Discuss and compare the shape and size of leaves and seeds

Match and sort – what's the same? What's different?

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Discuss and follow the class rules and behavioural expectations

Use resources carefully and appropriately and tidy them when they have finished

Develop friendly and respectful relationships with adults and peers

Take turns when using resources

# Out and About in Autumn

Foundation Stage Autumn One 2021

### Physical Development

Develop the skills required to manage a school day – lining up, mealtimes, dressing and undressing

Practise and improve gross motor skills e.g. climbing, jumping, balancing, throwing and kicking

Practice fine motor skills e.g. threading, cutting, writing, drawing and painting

Develop strength, agility and co-ordination using large and small equipment, inside and outside.

### Expressive Arts and Design

Use seeds, conkers, leaves and twigs to make autumn pictures and sculptures

Talk about colours and learn how to mix them

Listen to music and songs and join in with singing and music making

Dance and express feelings in response to music

Work and play with other children to act out stories, role-play familiar situations, imagine and pretend

### Literacy

Listen to lots of stories

Retell stories using small world props and story maps

Learn to recognise individual letters and say the sounds for them

Begin to blend those sounds to read short, regular words

Practise letter shapes and begin to write some letters correctly

### Understanding the World

Take an autumn walk around the school grounds. Look for signs of autumn!

Explain how the world around them changes as the seasons change.

Watch and talk about the weather

Visit the orchard, pick apples, make jam, apple crumble, bread and cake
