

Numeracy

- Can you find out how many people live in Castle Donington?
- How far away is Castle Donington from London?
- If you're walking through Donington, count using door numbers.
- Record the temperature in Castle Donington for week.

Out and About!

- Take a photograph of your favourite place in Castle Donington.
- Go for a walk around the locality and record what you see.
- Can you make a map of your route to school? Can you add symbols and a key?
- Go for a walk and make a journey stick.



Literacy

- Make a list of words connected to Castle Donington e.g. Airport, Race Track, Orchard School etc.
- Do you know, or can you write, your home address?
- Create an A-Z of Castle Donington e.g. A = Air Port
- Write down some of the words on street signs you can see in Castle Donington.

- What can you find out about your local area's history? How has it changed over time? You can use lots of tools to help you to research this:
 - Interview a grandparent/parent/neighbour
 - Visit a local museum
 - Search the internet for maps of the local area to see how they've changed.
