

Numeracy

- Make a visit to the local shop/supermarket and see what you can find that is less than £1.
- How many people were on the Titanic? Were there more male or female passengers?
- Can you find out how much it would cost for all types of passengers to buy a ticket for the Titanic.
- **Challenge!** Can you work out the difference between the costs for each class?



Out and About!

- Visit your local library or bookstore and find some non-fiction books about the Titanic or polar animals.
- Make a list of things that you would take with you if you were a polar explorer.



Literacy

- Draw and label a picture of the Titanic.
- Write a recount about your day on the ship.
- Make a fact file – What was the Titanic like for First and Third Class passengers?
- Research polar animals and create your own polar animal fact sheet.
- Find and read icy/winter poems. Challenge! Write your own.

Working with Others

- Work with an adult or friend to construct your very own small Titanic model. You could use junk modelling, Lego or any other materials.
- Create a board game for passengers on board the Titanic to play whilst on their journey.
- Play a card game or dominoes with people in your family.
