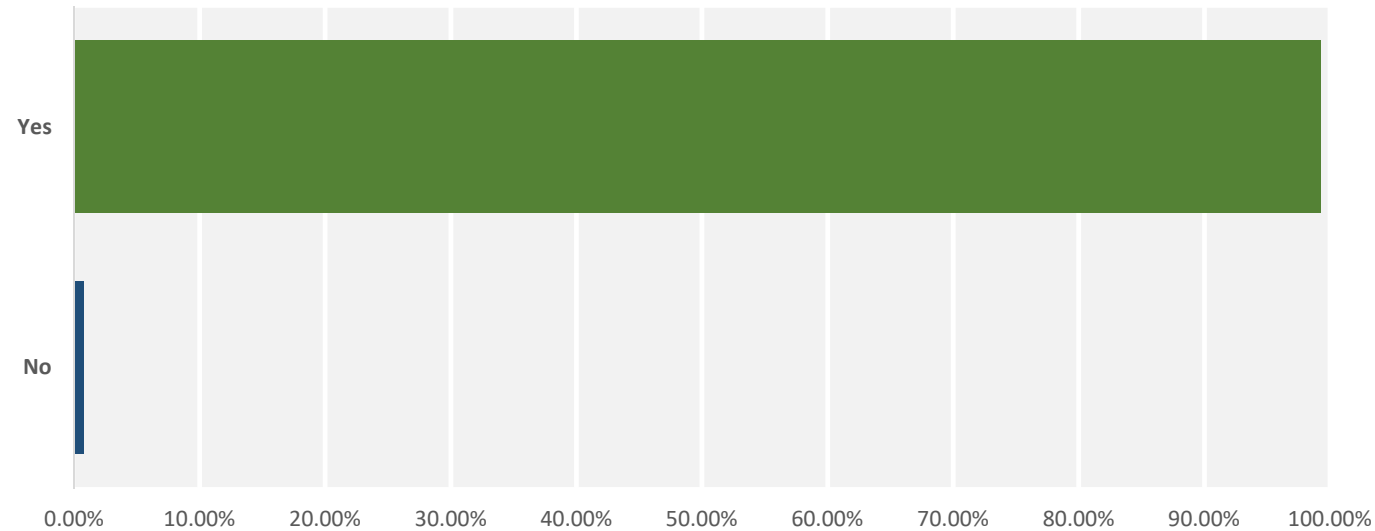

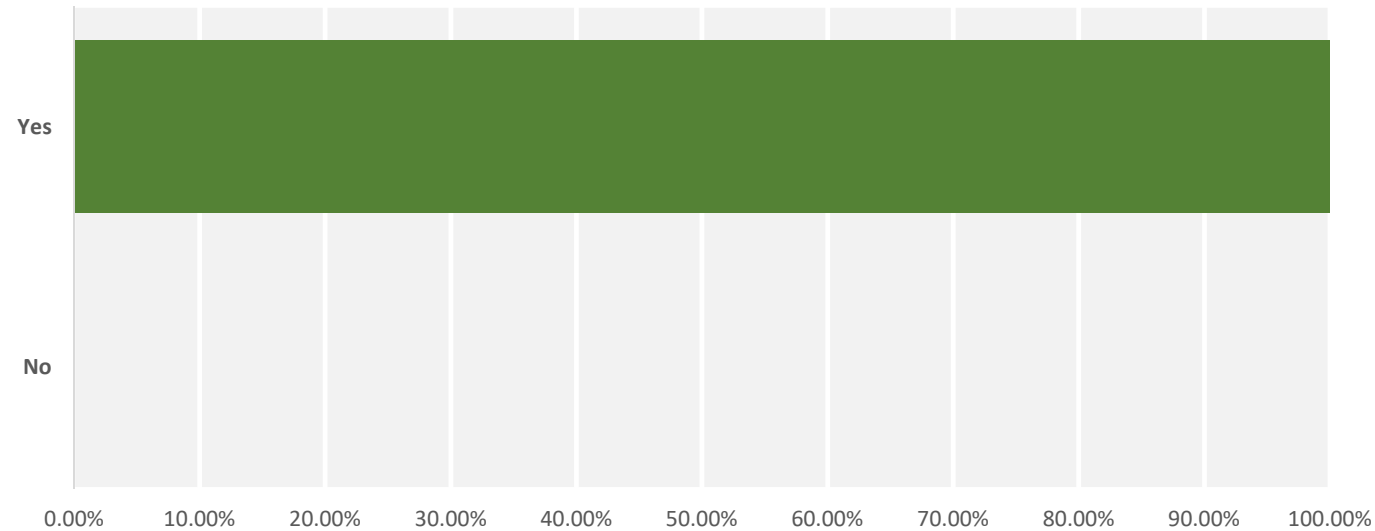


## Q2: My child feels safe at this school? [Yes/No]

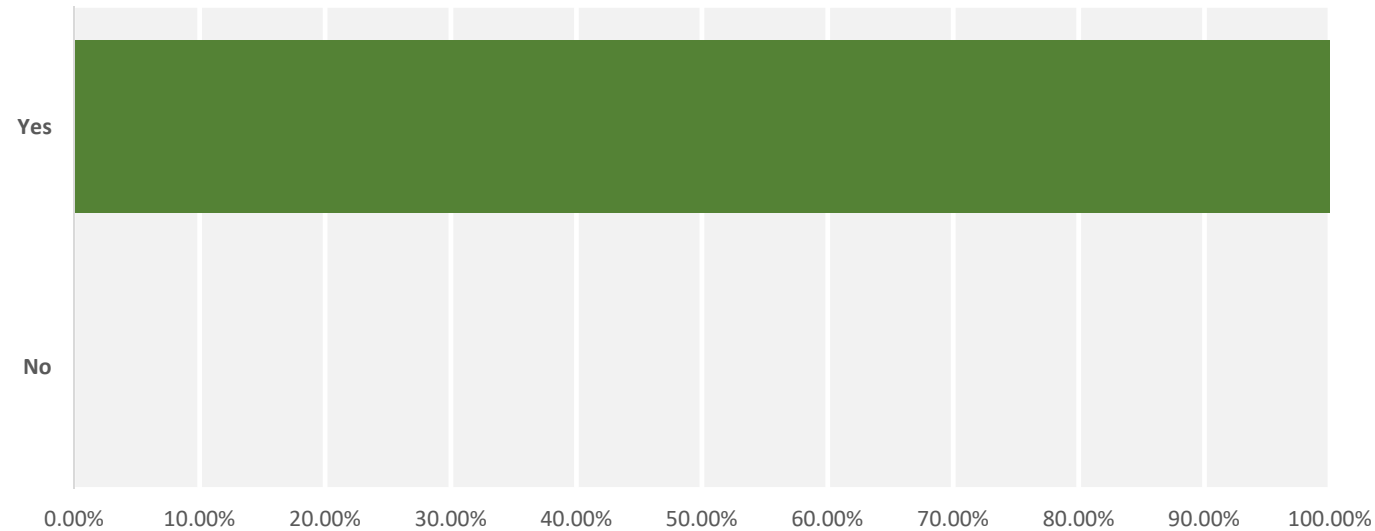


### Q3: The school is well-managed / well-led? [Yes/No]

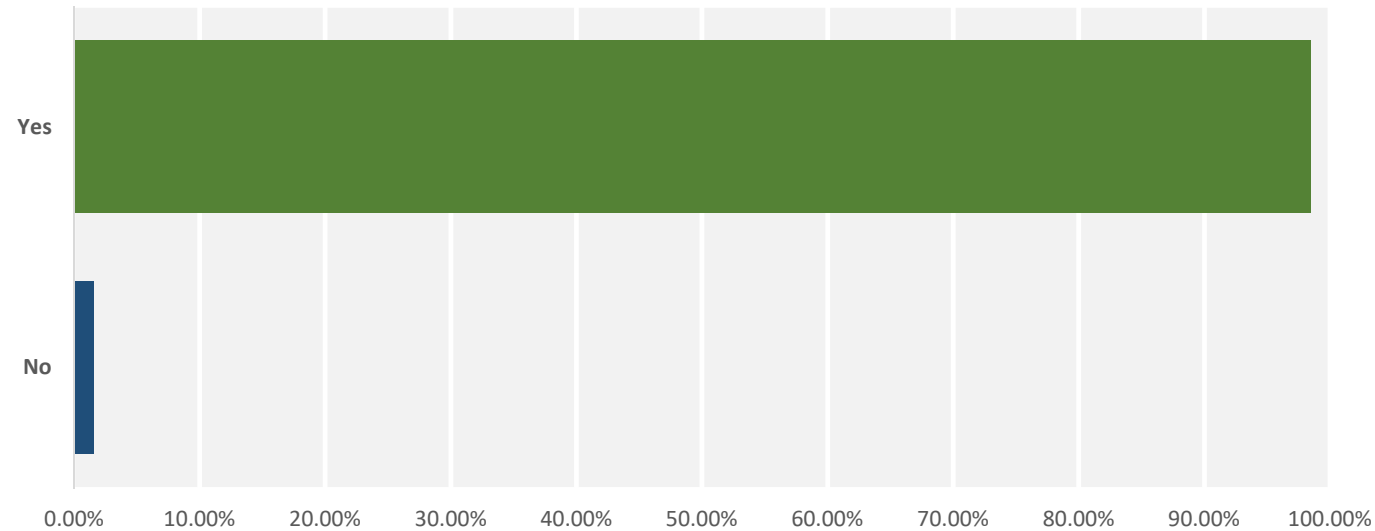


# Q4: The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved? [Yes/No]

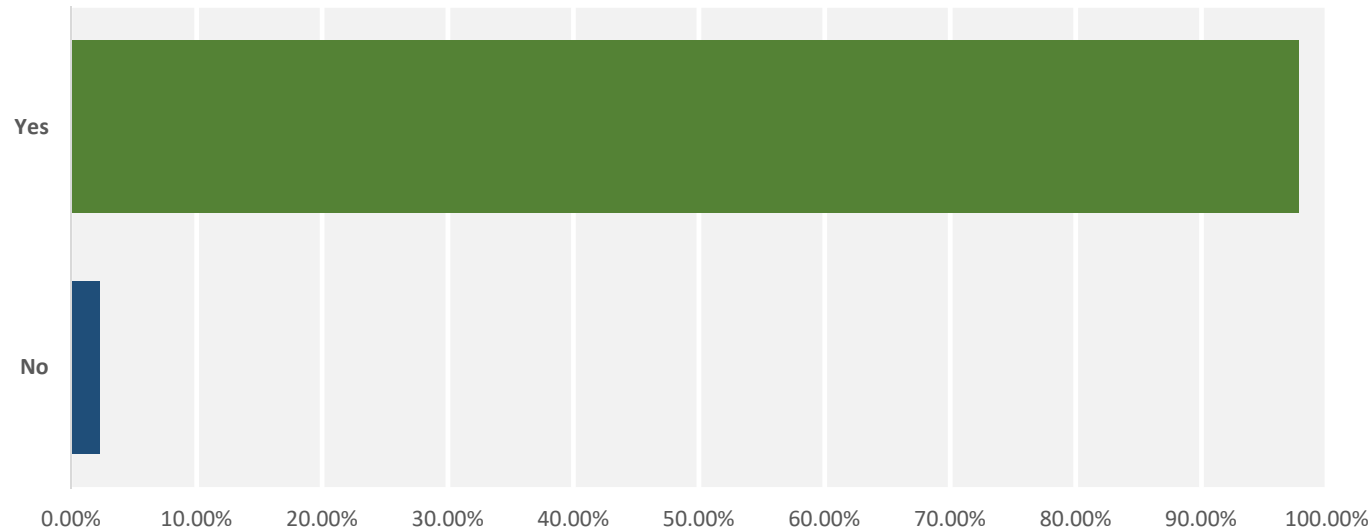

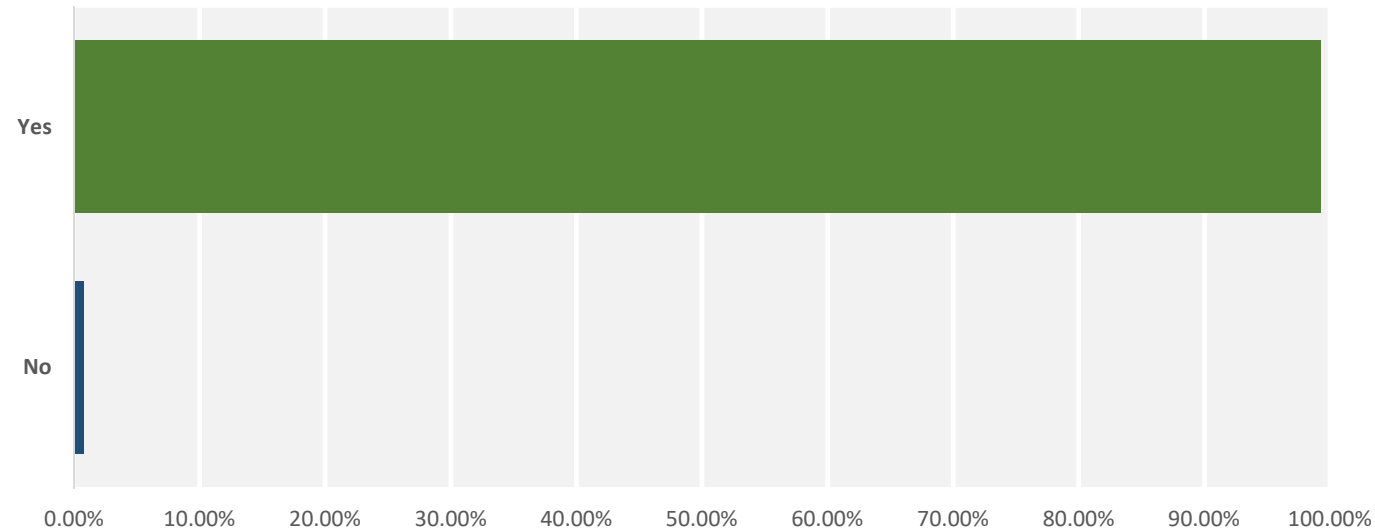

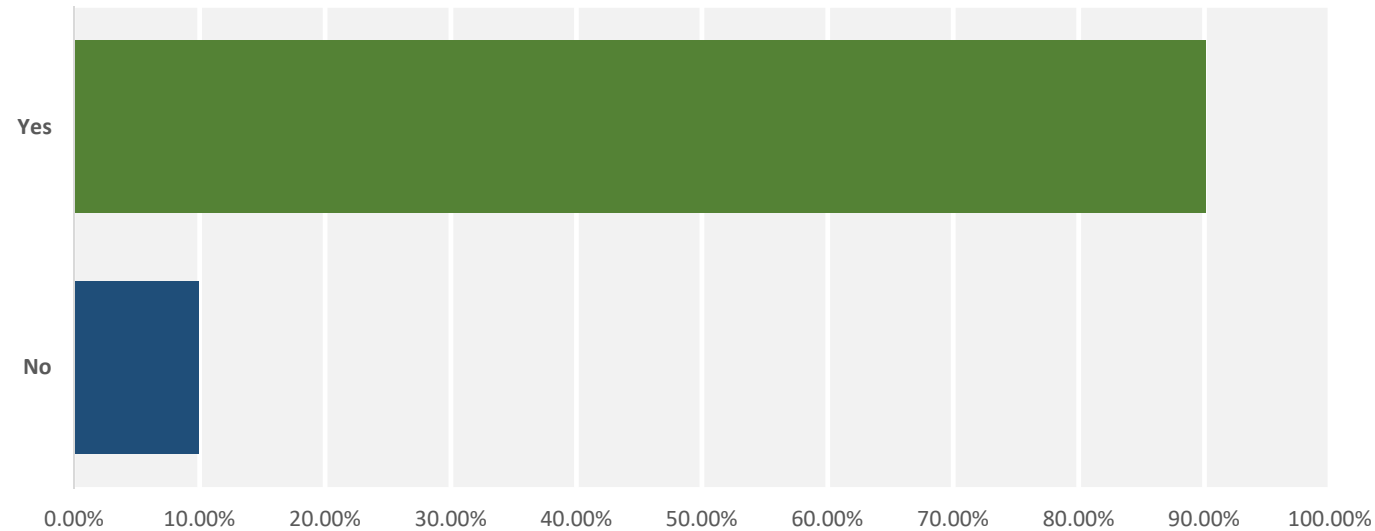

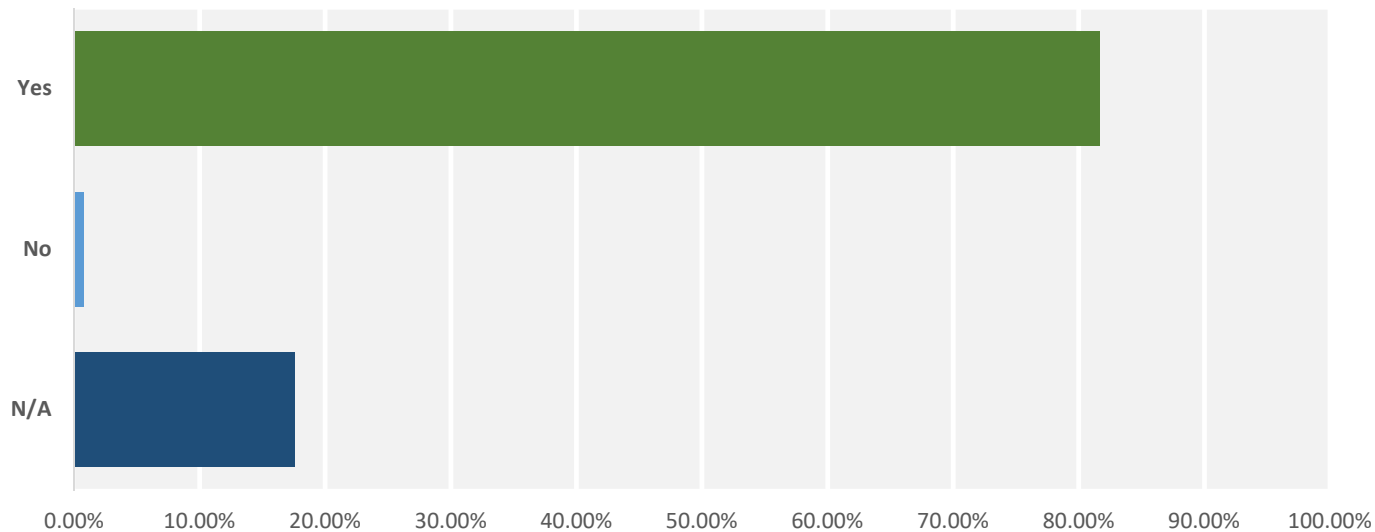

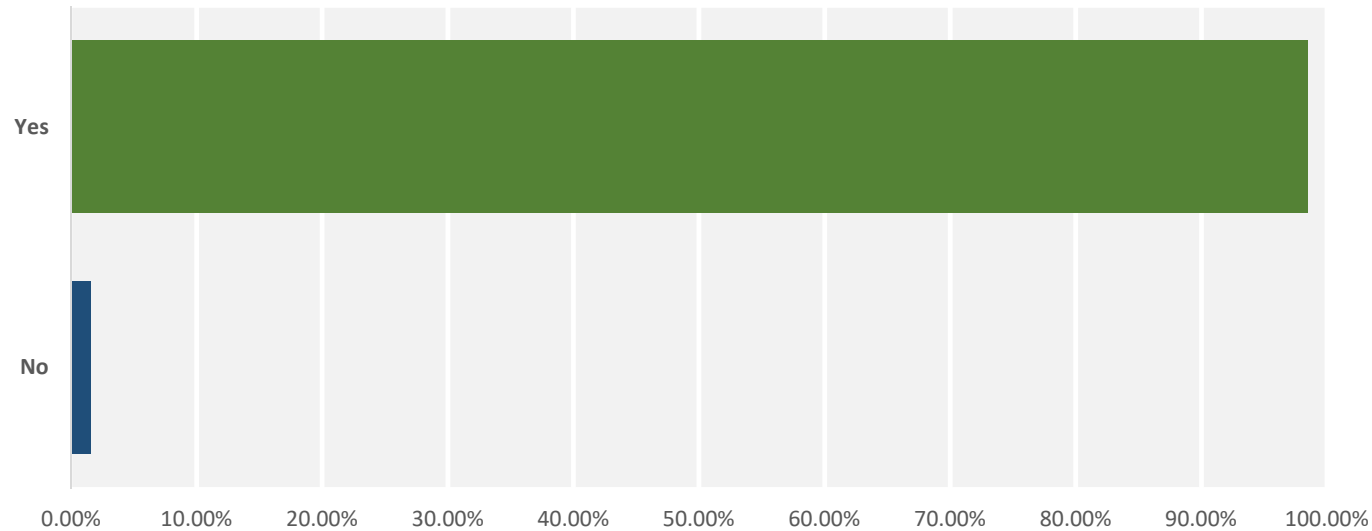

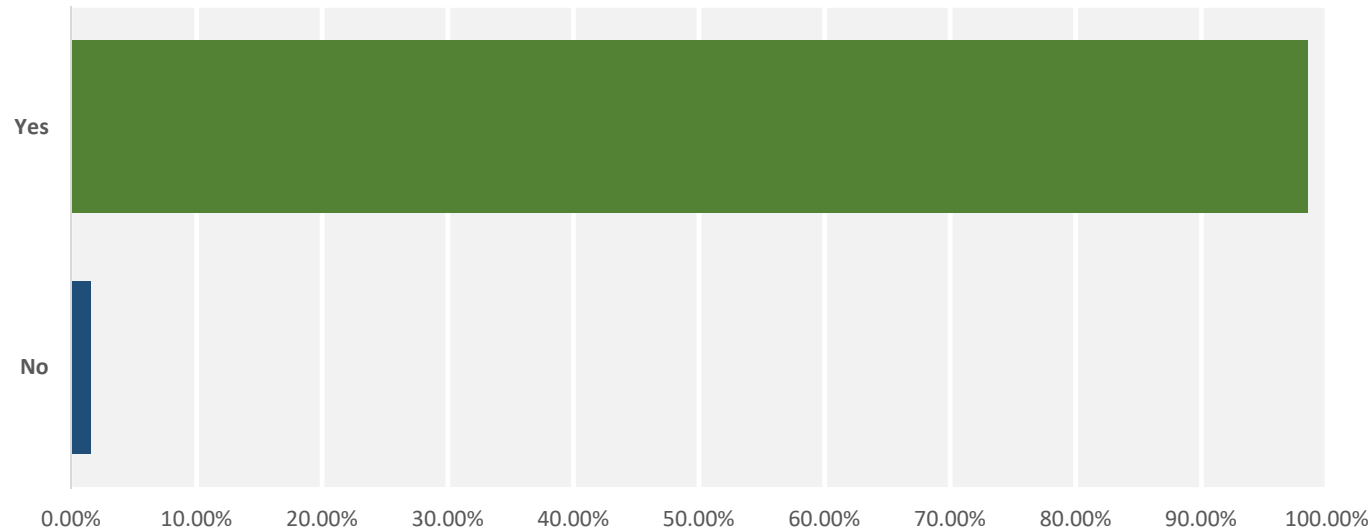

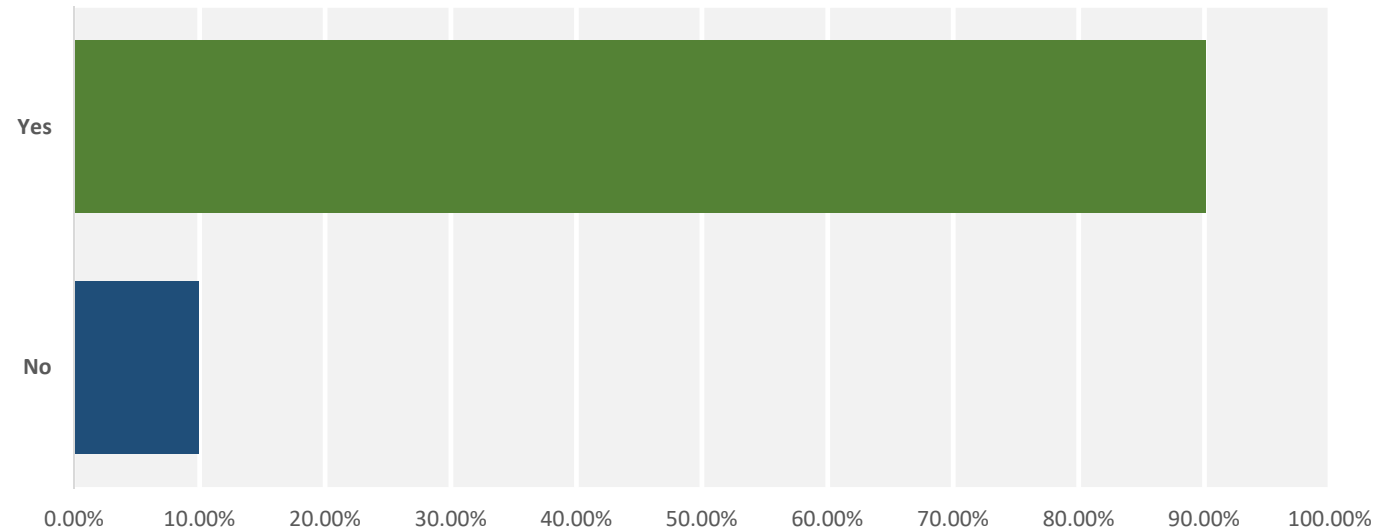

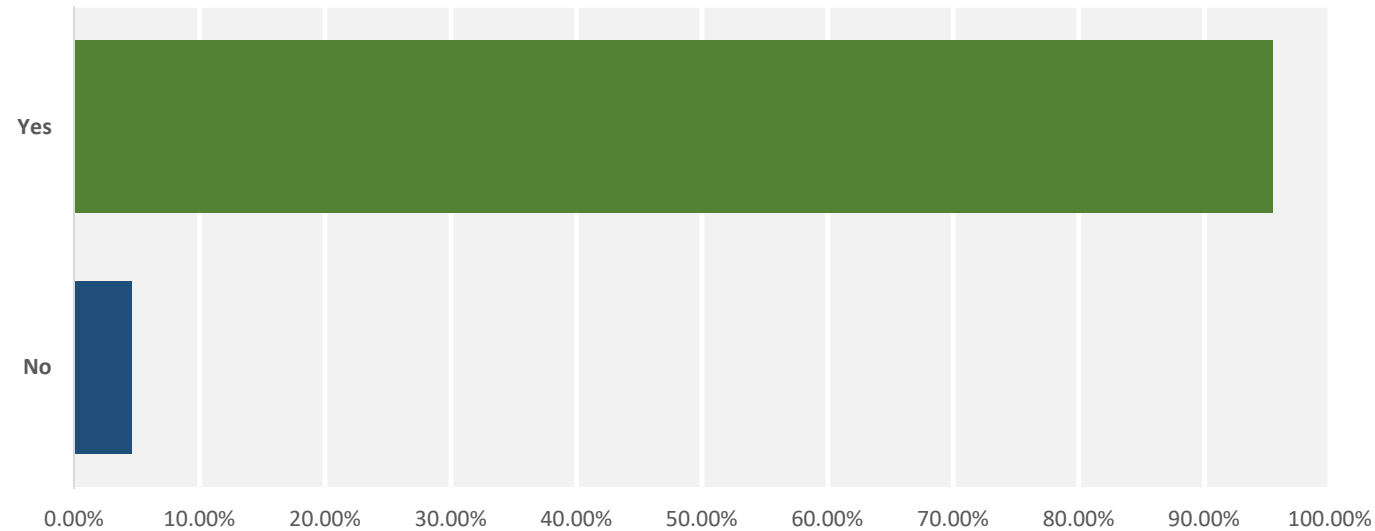

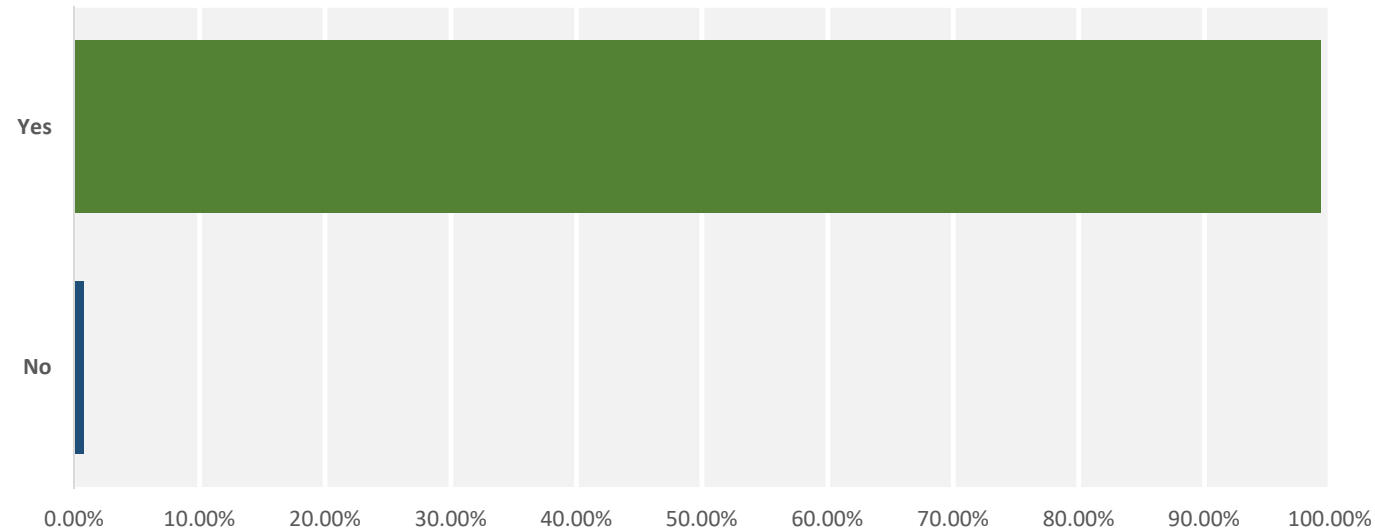

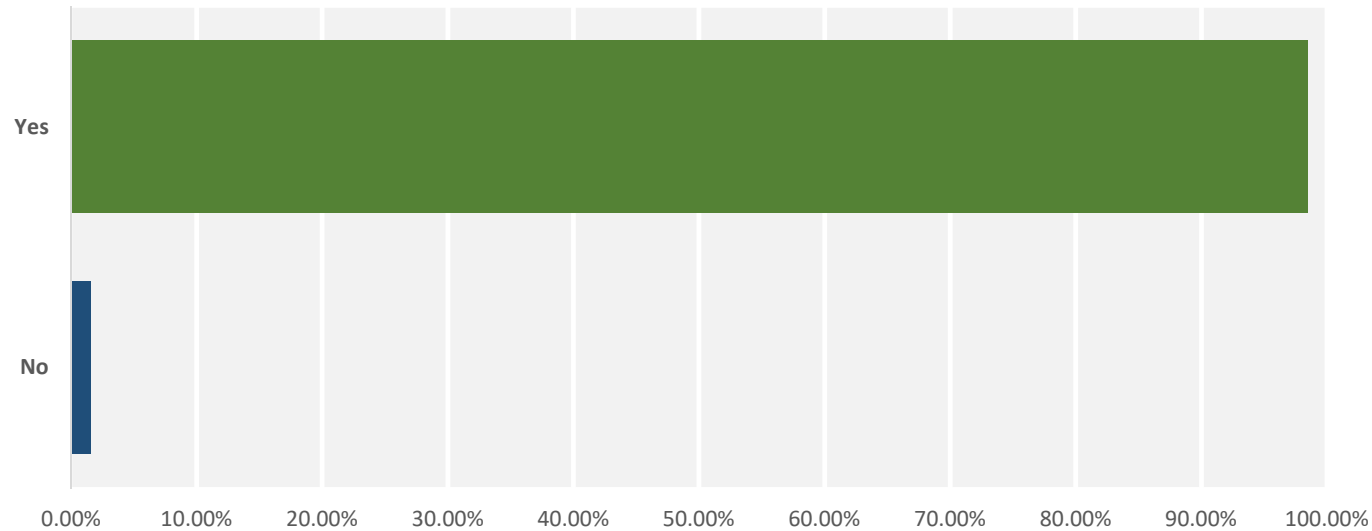

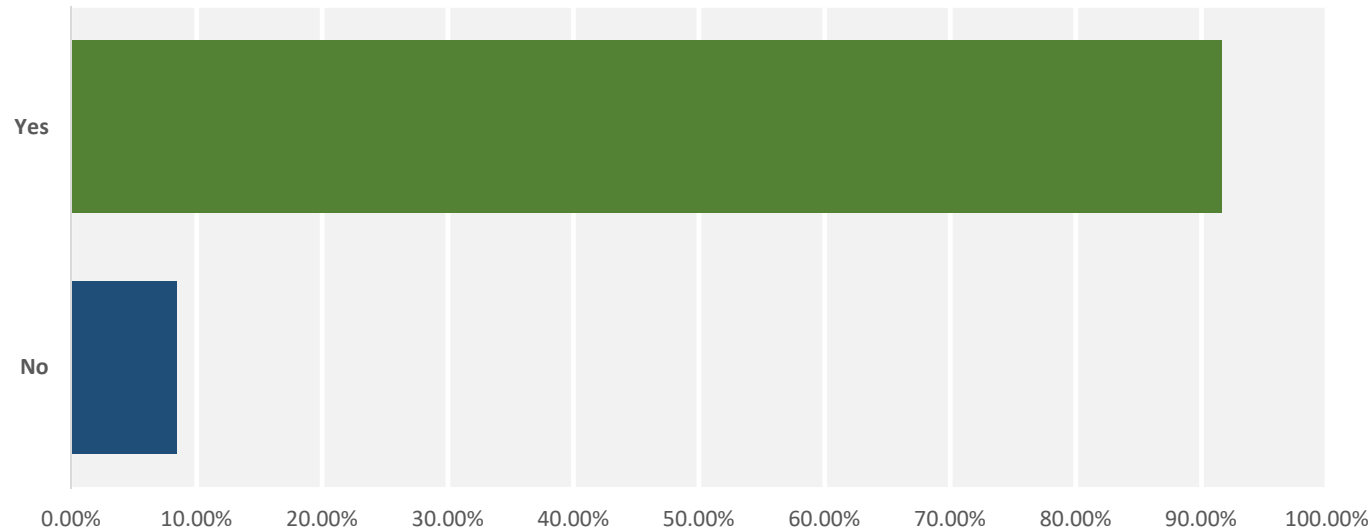
